This letter is to inform you that the above referenced general industrial stormwater facility permit is no longer required to sample and monitor stormwater discharges at the frequency established in the permit. The basis for this determination is due to the fact that the permit requires adequate stormwater best management practices (BMPs) to be in place and maintained at your facility to control the discharge of water contaminants associated with the industrial activity. In addition to BMP requirements, the permit also requires the documentation of regularly scheduled BMP evaluations and assessments within the facility's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). Pollutant benchmarks for the evaluation of BMPs continue to be applicable as a means to determine BMP effectiveness however stormwater samples are not required to be submitted to the department or taken at a required frequency. In the coming months the department will conduct permit modifications to remove the stormwater sampling requirements from your permit consistent with this notice. In the meantime this letter serves as documentation for waiver of the stormwater sampling permit requirement.

Please note that any sampling requirements of non-stormwater discharges contained in your permit remain in effect. Additionally, the department may require sampling and reporting as a result of illegal discharges, compliance issues, complaint investigations, or evidence of off-site impacts from activities at the facility. If such an action is needed, the department will specify in writing the sampling requirements, including such information as location and extent.
